Cruise The Petaluma River

Did you know a 200-room hotel once stood a few miles south of Petaluma at Donahue's Landing? Empty fields now cover the area where eight-car trainloads of tourists were barged from San Francisco. Did you know there was once a secret Navy installation at Gray's Ranch?

On April 20 and 21, leaving at 9 AM and 1 PM, join Ronn Patterson

and Dolphin Charters for a three-hour narrated trip on the Petaluma River. View the commercial and industrial aspects of this waterway as you depart the Petaluma Turning Basin in the downtown area, head downriver and enter a different world as the boat winds its way through the meadows and oxbows of this wetlands area towards the mouth of the river near the Hwy 37 overpass.

Learn about the history and importance of the river to the town of Petaluma and the surrounding countryside, and why it is still important today. Look around you (especially if you bring binoculars) to see the birds and wildlife that inhabit this special region as you cruise on your downriver and return journey. Children must be 8 years of age or older and the cost is \$40/person. Call

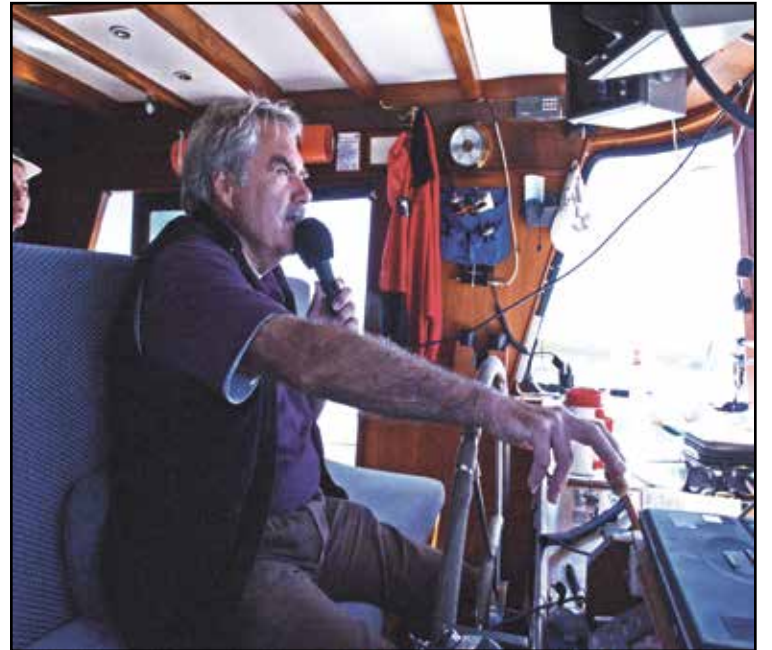
