## Celebrate Harvest Day At The Farm

**H**arvest Day at the Farm, Marin Agricultural Land Trust's annual autumn festival, will be held at Nicasio Valley Farms on Sunday, October 9th, from 10 AM to 5 PM. This year, Harvest Day celebrates the 25th anniversary of Marin Agricultural Land Trust (MALT), the first land trust in the United States to focus on farmland preservation.

Special activities will include a scavenger hunt, a coloring contest, square dancing, entertainment by children's recording artist Tim Cain, and songs by Suzie Schuene-man with a chorus of kids from San Pedro School in San Rafael.

Kids can scramble up hay-stacks, ride a pony, learn rope tricks, go for a hay ride, play games, make leathercrafts, and find their way through a

hay or corn maze. The whole family can lunch on delicious foods prepared with ingredients from Marin farms. Food for sale will include oysters, barbecued chicken, grass-fed beef hamburgers, local greens, organic ice cream, and pumpkin pie.

Local craftspeople will be selling their wares as well, including handspun wool, hand-knit sweaters, hand-made toy Holstein cows, and herbal soaps and oils. Environmental groups will describe their efforts to protect Marin's resources, and the 4-H Club and other local organizations will offer homemade treats and fun activities.

Admission to Harvest Day at the Farm is free. Nicasio Valley Farms is located 1/4 mile north of the Nicasio Village Square. For more information, visit [malt.org](http://malt.org) or phone 415.663.1338.
